The meeting was called to order at 11:58 am.

Committee chairperson Christine King discussed the history of the committee and committee members were introduced.

1. Improvements at Douglass High School

No funding source has been identified for this project however there is a need. Renovations need to include restrooms. Architect from Peckham and Wright will be touring the building on Oct. 30, 2012 along with district staff and building administrators, to develop a scope of work and preliminary budget. Work could not begin until 2015 due to other projects.

The need for renovation arose from additional activities being added.

Douglass could expand and be used for adult education. Students would use south end and upper levels. Adult education would be supervised by security so there would be no crossover with students.

2. Midway Parking Lot Improvements

The need for improvements has been identified but no funding source identified.

A meeting with building administrators and PTA was held to identify the needs.

A plan was developed to separate bus traffic and parent traffic. Add a separate entrance for delivery traffic and additional parking.

Phase I – create bus loop to separate traffic

Phase II – widen to 3 lanes and make parent entrance. Add a fence and sidewalk for pedestrian traffic.

Storm water has been addressed in the plan.

The improvements will have to meet MoDot standards. They have no issues with the plans right now.

Engineering Survey and Services will proceed with plans to bid out the project in March/April 2013 with work beginning in the summer. If plan moves forward there will not be summer school at Midway.

From a safety standpoint, this is a good plan for dual access.
